When I walk, I often listen to music, entertainment on the way.

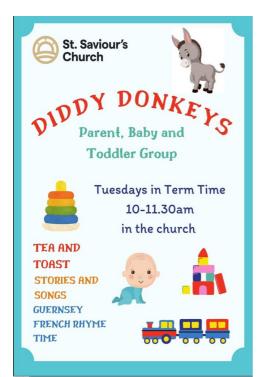
But rather than in the ear headphones, or large over the ear headphones that block out everything but the music, I use bone-conducting headphones that mean I can still hear what is going on around me.

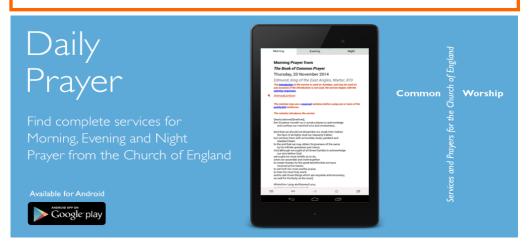


Exercise Class
