Thought for April

“Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.”

Matthew 5 vs 9

When reflecting on the world and all the current conflicts, the following meditation came to mind, written by Eddie Askew;

Lord, I don't know how it is, but we've turned the beauty of the world you made into a desert. Cut down the forests of your love with sharpened blades of hate. Polluted the rivers of your grace with selfishness. We've brought division, built barriers, marked boundaries. And from the steps and platforms of our dogmas, shouted war. We've found it easy to destroy, by indifference as much as evil. We've learned now how hard it is to build and re-create.

And yet you love us. Can love be so elastic that it stretches out and out to take in all we've done and still forgive? You tell us so. And show it in torn hands, marked hard by crucifixion.

Lord, stand with us at the barricades. And help us, not to fight, but to dismantle them. Help us to open up the road to reconciliation. To plant and water seeds of trust. To reach out hands of love, take partners, dance forgiveness.

As the empty cross and empty grave of Easter approach, may we consider Jesus “peacemaker” challenge in the church, the community, the world and even in our own lives.
