The other week I went with a group of people to see the film "The Jesus Revolution", a film based on the Jesus Movement in California in the 1960's. Pastor Chuck Smith opens his church to the hippy community, stressing the importance of open doors, acceptance of all, no matter what, which is at the heart of the Jesus message of good news.
